
2011 Single Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon Yountville ~ Napa Valley Barrel Sample

Winemaker Notes from Rob Lawson

2011 was a late, challenging and wet vintage (depending on when you picked). Many qualitative decisions were made throughout harvest and fermentation resulting in excellent wine quality.

The perfumed nose of ripe, fresh strawberry, black raspberry, and hints of tobacco and dry herbs lead to the classic and always enticing palate of mature plum, black cherry and dark chocolate lengthened by the integrated background of cedar, nutmeg and vanilla. Soft tannins provide ample body and finish

Cooperage: The Single Vineyard Cabernet was aged 24 months in 70% new, French oak barrels with a variety of coopers to add complexity and highlight the many nuances of the wine. All grapes were cluster and berry sorted, then whole berry fermented.
